What is Google Classroom?

Think of Google Classroom (GC) as the child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use GC to share assignments, homework, newsletters, and much more with students



Getting Started



Each child was set up an account the same format as their school Domain login
@windhill.herts.sch.uk
e.g.: 19FredB@windhill.herts.sch.uk
is a year 3 student called Fred B
Passwords remain the same as previous term





Click on **SIGN IN** in the upper right hand corner of the browser window.


