#### 21<sup>st</sup> Century Curriculum Windhill21 - delivering a curriculum for the future.....

Our aspirational curriculum at Windhill21 has been designed to excite, provoke, challenge, and inspire our children.

Windhill21 teachers and leaders keep up to date with all the latest research from 'thinkers' in the education sphere and we have crafted this curriculum for our children to ensure it is rooted in current best practice.

Each year, children will study three broad topics, which have been selected to entice children to engage with rigorous history and geography content, alongside current global themes. These global themes, such as 'equality' and 'society' are what bring our curriculum to life; we provoke children to consider current, real-world, gritty issues such as feminism and equal rights for women and understand how history has shaped thinking today.

Prioritising oracy in lessons enables every child to engage with the depth our curriculum provides and that is what makes it aspirational for all. We explicitly teach ambitious vocabulary to deepen learning for all children, regardless of their background or starting point. Teachers use responsive instruction to ensure that every child is supported and challenged. We ensure that children master skills and knowledge through small steps, reasoning and problem solving. Responsive instruction, recall, retrieval, mini quizzes and skilful questioning are all used to make learning stick.

The curriculum is supported using Windhill21's extensive and well-maintained grounds and outstanding facilities which comprise of spacious sports fields, a multi-use games area and focused outdoor learning areas. Our Forest School enthuses learning in all aspects of the curriculum and our thriving garden is used to support practical science, enterprise and cookery. We have invested in high-quality equipment in our playgrounds to ensure that our children are engaged purposefully and can develop all-round physical fitness.

Windhill21 is at the forefront of the rapidly changing world of technology. Our Media Suite contains the latest computing technology as well as our envious and unique Immersion Room. Class sets of iPads enhance learning along with our filmmaking and photography initiatives.

Pupil learning is embellished by a wide range of clubs, inspiring visits and trips and 'Wonder Days and Weeks'. Opportunities are woven into the curriculum to enthuse children, making learning more memorable, the experience of which may kindle future interest in specific aspects of life. The annual residential trip to The Somme in France in year 6 provides a fusion of learning: practice speaking the French language; understanding the French culture and the appreciation of World War 1 history.

Success in inter-schools' sports competitions are a regular feature of Windhill21 and all children are encouraged to experience the challenges and the joy of participating in activities beyond the immediate environment. Windhill21 is committed to ensuring that all children's talents and abilities are nurtured, challenged and celebrated.

All pupils at Windhill21 are ambassadors within school and the wider community. All are given responsibilities and flourish in the knowledge that they are trusted. Year 6 pupils have the opportunity to become House Captains, Play Leaders, Digital Leaders or Arts Ambassadors – something for everyone.
