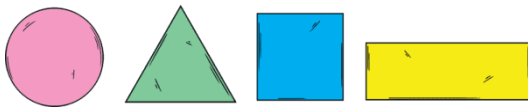

Shape and space.



The concept of shape and space can be quite abstract to some children, and it can be challenging to visualise the properties of shape, for example how many faces does a cuboid have? As adults, we often use gestures or mini sketches to help us visualise these concepts.
