Now that the weather is improving, we thought we would provide you with some outdoor Maths Opportunities!

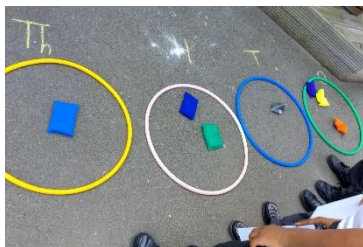
Have you ever considered using chalk to create a multiplication flower? Each petal is a multiple of the middle number (e.g. 9) and the factors are around the outside.
