Festival of Literature

Year 5 and 6 enjoyed a fascinating - and fun-filled - session with poet Matt Goodfellow at the Festival of Literature in Bishop's Stortford College. Matt, a former teacher, talked about how

writing poetry gives children a voice, huge freedom...and a way of expressing their cultural heritage and identity.

He went onto explain how his poems are categorised in three ways: events in his life, events in other people's lives...and general funny things! We were moved from laughter, with 'A Special Badger' to thoughtful empathy with 'Callum'. The children truly relished the session and were delighted to be gifted signed books at the end.

A Paralympian Visits Windhill21

Today, some of our Key Stage Two children, had the privilege of meeting Chris from WheelPower (the national charity for wheelchair sport). He delivered an assembly which was very inspiring. The children learned about physical disabilities, adapted sport and the power of resilience and determination. Chris, who is a former GB power weight athlete, brought in the Paralympic torch for the children to see and hold. What an incredible Monday morning for the pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6!



In year 3, we have been lucky enough to begin our Life School lessons. Life School is a hands-on approach to learning to help create well rounded citizens with skills for the real world. The

curriculum consists of gardening, cookery, music and languages, where children from each class will participate in each lesson on a six-week cycle.



Currently fifteen children from Beatles have developed their understanding of seasonal harvests, understanding the impact on seasons for plant growth, learnt how to plant and harvest crops they have grown in a "wellies to bellies" approach to learning. Whilst the remaining fifteen children of Beatles have learnt skills in cookery through health and safety, combining flavours and even tested out some recipes like homemade

pizza! In Handel, life school afternoons

consist of developing fluency and vocabulary of different languages as well as music where the children recognise different genres of music, comparing different styles, practise finding rhythms and beats before they perform a final piece they have been learning.
