### Introduction

### Jewellery:

Watches and small, plain ear studs may be worn but in the interests of safety, no other jewellery may be worn to school.

Pupils **must** remove watches and ear studs for PE.

## **Physical Education**

It is important that pupils have their PE kit in school on their class PE days.  
All items should be named and kept in a suitable named bag.  
PE bags are available from the school's uniform supplier.

## **Hairstyles and Accessories:**

Hairstyles should be natural.

Long hair (hair below chin level) must be tied back with plain dark hair ties and/or clips throughout the school day. This is to ensure that hair doesn't marginalise the support for pupils' learning and is also in line with health and safety guidance. This applies to all pupils

Extensions and unnecessary accessories are not allowed, nor are unnatural styles such as shaved patterns, colourings and sculpted gel styles.

Nail polish, temporary transfers and tattoos and make up are not permitted.

- Navy knitted v-neck jumper or cardigan with logo \*
- Grey or white socks
- Black shoes

- Navy v-neck knitted jumper or cardigan with logo \*

- Charcoal grey shorts or navy gingham summer dress
- White polo shirt

- Cobalt blue polo shirt with logo \*

- White sports socks
- Navy hoodie with logo for outdoors \*
